# 6. NOTICED PUBLIC HEARINGS:

# City of McFarland Annexation No. 18

This proposal is to annex approximately 2,138 acres of land, generally located: West of 99, Hanawalt Rd going South to Whisler Rd, Garzoli Rd going East to 99 FWY. The lands East of 99 FWY, Sherwood Ave. going South to Whisler Road, and 99 FWY going East to Driver Road. This annexation was initiated by the City for the purpose of future development. The surrounding properties are agricultural land, including two dairies and numerous agricultural ponds, and scattered rural residences. This proposal does not have 100% landowner consent. The applicant has been informed that notice, hearing and protest hearing will not be waived. (*Resolution*)

#### CSA 17 Annexation No. 15

This proposal is to annex approximately 41.81 acres of land, generally located on Breckenridge Road east of Morning Drive in East Bakersfield, Orangewood Area. This annexation was initiated by the County for the purpose of meeting service requirements of the subdivision as approved by the County. The surrounding properties are: West-Vacant Commercial, North-Developed Residential, East-Developed Residential, South-Railroad. This proposal does not have 100% landowner consent. The applicant has been informed that notice, hearing and protest hearing will not be waived. (*Resolution*)

# 7. <u>DETERMINATION PROCEEDING:</u>

### North of the River Sanitation District Annexation No. 112

This proposal is to annex two parcels of approximately 6.42 acres of land located: Parcel A: West of Creek Road and North of 7<sup>th</sup> Standard; Parcel B: North of Renfro Road and West of Jason Road. This annexation was initiated by the property owners for the purpose of gaining sewer services. The surrounding properties are: Parcel A – The area is surrounded by industrial uses, and Parcels B – The area is surrounded by estate residential. This proposal has 100% landowner consent. The applicant has requested that notice, hearing and protest hearing be waived. (*Resolution*)

### Lost Hills Utility District Annexation No. 20

This proposal is to annex approximately 12.05 acres of land, on the east side of Lamberson Drive and North of Hwy 46. This annexation was initiated by the property owners for the purpose of gaining potable water and sewer services for the future development of the former County airport property. The surrounding properties

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are agricultural, residential, county park and open ground. This proposal has 100% landowner consent. The applicant has requested that notice, hearing and protest hearing be waived. (Resolution)

#### CSA 60 Annexation No. 11

This proposal is to annex approximately 137.36 acres of land, generally located on the north side of Merle Haggard Drive, east of Airport Dr. This annexation was initiated by the County for the purpose of street sweeping and drainage facility maintenance services. The surrounding properties are: mostly vacant industrial land with only one developed parcel. This proposal has 100% landowner consent. The applicant has requested that notice, hearing and protest hearing will be waived. (*Resolution*)
